Purpose and legal basis of the data processing

The personal data pertaining to me will be published on the respective websites on the intranet on a voluntary basis following my personal selection above or will be disclosed to former employees of the Max Planck Institute for Chemistry upon request. The legal basis for this is my informed, voluntary and written declaration of consent pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, lit. a European General Data Protection Regulation.

Data recipients and categories of data recipients

Possible categories of data recipients who can view personal data pertaining to me are employees of the MPIC or of the MPG, depending on my selection (see above). Additionally, former employees may receive information about personal data concerning me if I have included this option in my selection (above). The MPIC and the MPG use external service providers as processors; however, the responsibility for data processing remains with the MPG.

Duration of the processing

The personal data pertaining to me will be processed until I revoke this declaration of consent or until I request deletion. If my contact details given here should no longer be up-to-date and if messages can no longer be delivered, they will be deleted six months after discovery to that effect.

My rights pursuant to the European General Data Protection Regulation

I have the right to revoke my declaration of consent at any time without any prejudice for the future. I have the right of access to my personal data and the right of correction should my personal data be incorrect or obsolete. I can demand the deletion of the personal data pertaining to me as well as restrict their processing and have the personal data pertaining to me transferred to me. Right of appeal to a data protection authority

I have the right to appeal to a data protection authority. The supervisory authority responsible for the MPG is BayLDA (Bavarian Data Protection Authority), Postfach 606, 91511 Ansbach.
